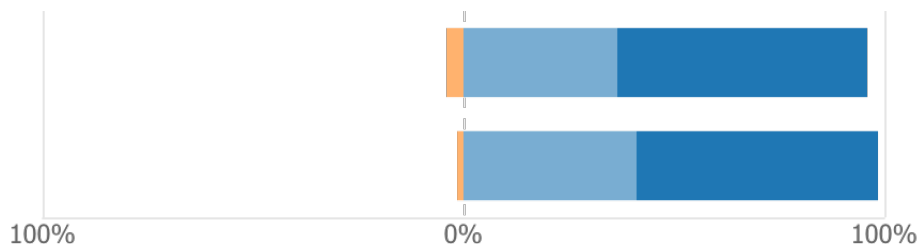


#### 6. The Mechanism of Anaesthesia. *Dr Chris Edge.*

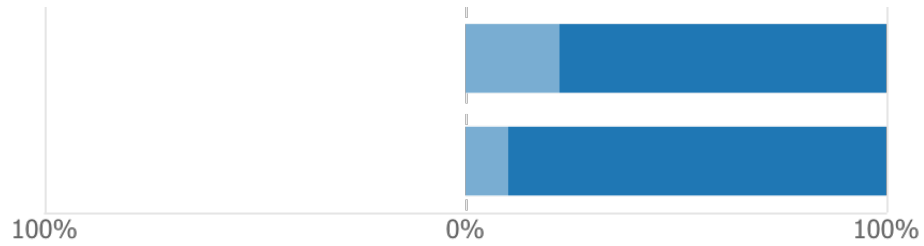

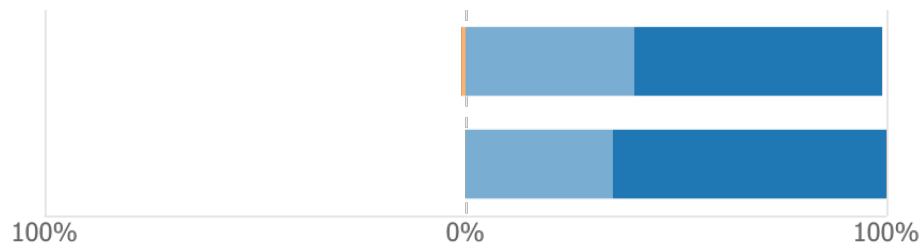

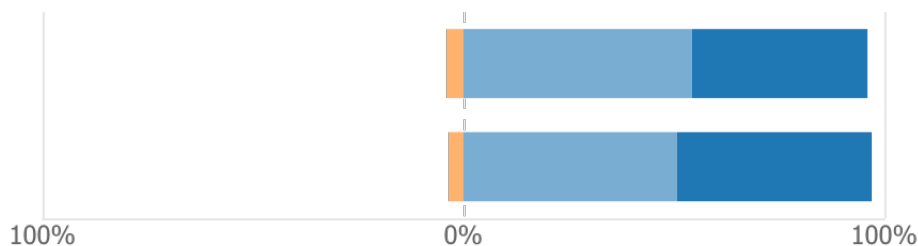

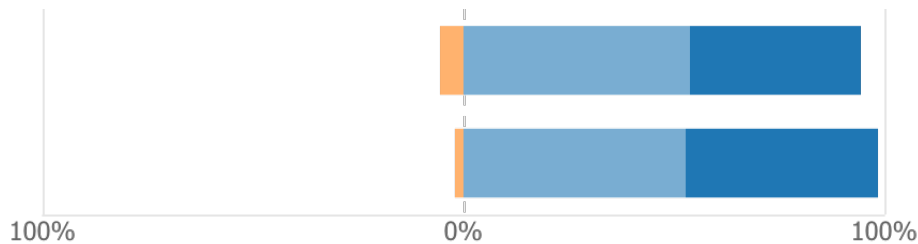

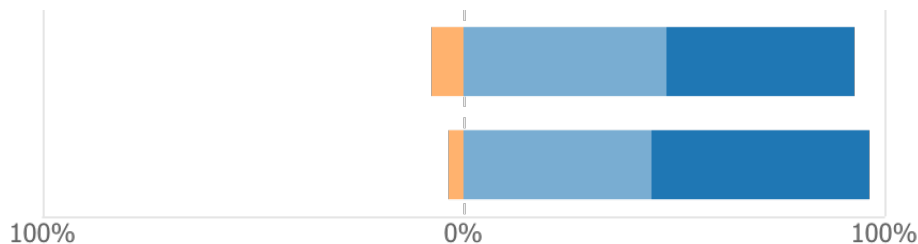

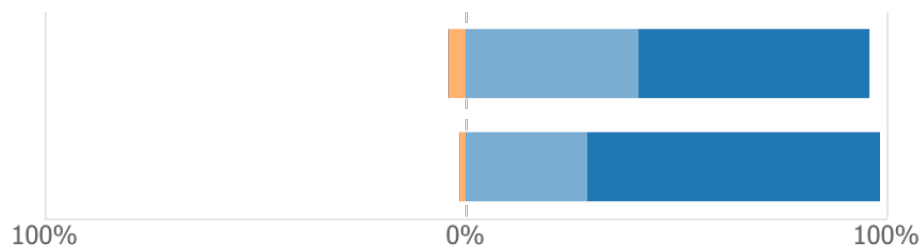


### 14. The Development of the Oxvent Ventilator. *Professor Andrew Farmery.*

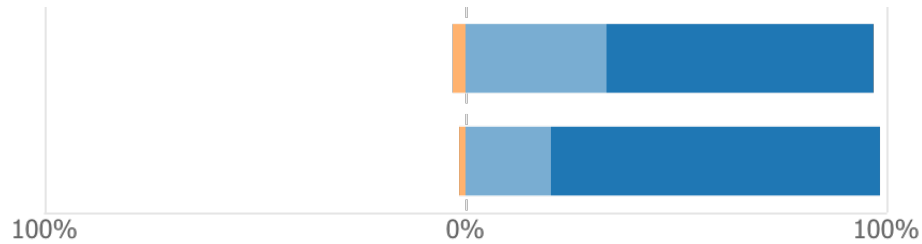
